demonstrates how to effectively add depth by incorporating a photo backdrop into the surrounding scenery.

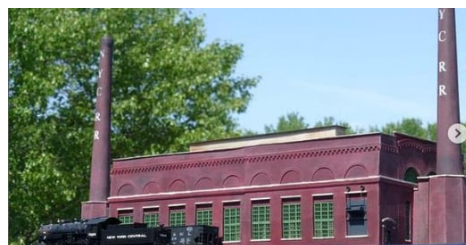
